

Austin Watering Restrictions

The City of Austin is the water supplier to Westminster Glen Estates, and we therefore are required to follow the City's water restrictions. Currently, Conservation Stage Restrictions apply:

CONSERVATION STAGE WATER RESTRICTIONS

- Hose-end (manual) irrigation may take place between midnight and 10 a.m. and between 7 p.m. and midnight **two** days per week:

Odd House Numbers: Wednesday **and/or** Saturday

Even House Numbers: Thursday **and/or** Sunday

- Automatic sprinkler systems may operate between midnight and 5 a.m. and between 7 p.m. and midnight **one** day per week on your watering day.

Even House Numbers: Thursday

- Please ensure that your system has a working rain sensor, or operate the system manually when rain is forecasted.
- Washing vehicles at home is allowed if you use a hose with an atomic shutoff or bucket.
- Charity car washes are allowed at commercial car washes.
- Fountains must recirculate water.
- Restaurants may not serve water unless requested by a customer.
- Commercial properties (including restaurants and bars) may only operate patio misters between 4 p.m. and midnight.
- Wasting water is prohibited.

CONSERVATION STAGE WATER EXEMPTIONS

- Watering with drip irrigation, a hand-held hose or a refillable container
- Watering trees with a Treegator®, soaker hose or automatic tree bubbler
- Watering vegetable gardens with a soaker hose
- Pressure washing sidewalk/driveway/deck/patio/paved areas/home siding/fence
